First Aid

Advanced Care Yorkshire offers a number of first aid courses, including a basic first aid course and basic life support (incorporating CPR training).

Knowledge of first aid is important for everyone, but especially within a care setting where you may be working with more sick or vulnerable people. Quick responses and basic knowledge saves lives.

Basic First Aid Course. This half day course is suitable for anyone who requires a basic knowledge of first aid for their job role or as a refresher.

The course includes:

- How to undertake a primary survey.
- Dealing with an unconscious casualty.
- Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
- Heart Attacks and Strokes
- Choking, shock, epilepsy, fits and asthma
- Bleeds, bandages, breaks, burns and poisoning
- Vomiting, diarrhea, food poisoning, and diabetes
- Accidents
- Legislation and RIDDOR Regulations



Training methods: Tutor led theory work, practical demonstrations, simulation and group discussion. Candidates will take away with them a comprehensive course handout.

Assessment is a thorough observation and assessment of practical elements and a multi-choice test paper which is marked by the Tutor and then verified by an assessor, for Quality Assurance purposes. To gain a certificate a course mark in excess of 80% is required. On successful completion of the course, students will receive a Certificate which will remain valid for one year from date of issue.

Employers will receive all necessary paperwork to provide an auditable paper trail
