Passport to Care

This course is designed to tackle all the missing parts of care that are not covered in any other course. It shows in detail all the nitty gritty parts of the industry, the bits that frighten a new member of staff as they are unaware of what to expect. This course is designed to show existing Carers and Personal assistants the correct way of carrying out procedures and serves as a refresher for those who have been in the industry for some time and who may have unwittingly picked up bad or dangerous practices. It is particularly useful for new staff with no knowledge or experience of the Health Care industry incorporating the different aspects of caring for someone whether that someone is a friend, relative or a Service User in a professional manner



This full day course includes:

- Understanding the main principles of care and definition of Care related terms
- Review the Role, duties and responsibilities of a Carer/Personal Assistant
- Understand Personal Care and how to effectively help someone wash or bath
- Know how to recognize the signs and symptoms of potential areas of concern, i.e pressure areas, crease areas, and skin folds
- Bed bathing and the correct Moving and Handling techniques for bed bound Service Users
- Continence, incontinence, catheters and promoting independence for the Service User
- Communication
- Correct Recording
- Correct terminology for recording
- Dressing/undressing someone who has had a stroke or has a disability

Training methods: Lectures, group discussion, activities and demonstrations. Students will take away with them a comprehensive course handout.

Assessment is through a written test paper which is marked by the Tutor and then verified by an assessor, for Quality Assurance purposes. To gain a certificate a course mark in excess of 80% is required. On successful completion of the course, students will receive a Certificate which will remain valid for one year from date of issue. Employers will receive all necessary paperwork to provide an auditable paper trail
